ALARM RECALL

- A. Persons responding to an alarm but failing to arrive in time to respond on an apparatus shall remain at the station until the alarm is recalled or an Officer at the station releases you.
- B. It is the responsibility of the I.C. to recall an alarm once the incident has been stabilized and no additional resources are necessary.
- C. Incidents recalled prior to the arrival of Fire or EMS personnel should be responded to by the Duty Officer for confirmation and information gathering.
